## CACS Young Chemist Award Program

### PURPOSE

The CACS Young Chemist Award Program was established by Tri-State Chinese American Chemical Society (CAC S) in 2003. The Award is dedicated to promote young chemists among Chinese American in the Tri-State areas. CACS is proud to announce Young Chemist Awards 2009 program to recognize excellence of outstanding high school students and support them to develop career in chemistry-related fields upon entering college.

### GENERAL GUIDELINES

CACS Young Chemist Award will award undergraduate scholarships to outstanding students, in September for use during the upcoming academic year. The awards will be granted on the basis of merit to those who will be college freshmen in the upcoming academic year, and who have outstanding potential and intend to pursue careers in chemistry-related fields.

Each scholarship awards a one-time fund of minimal \$200 towards tuition payment. The program committee intends to award two or more CACS young chemist awards each year. Nominees for this award must include in their application materials a statement of interest in career in chemistry-related field upon entering college.

### ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for the Award, a student must:

- Be a full-time Grade 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> high school student
- Have a GPA above 3.3, a minimum SAT 2000 and be in the top fifteenth of the class
- Parents must be Tri -State CACS members
- Be a United States citizen, or a legal resident alien (please submit a photocopy of the Alien Registration Card).
